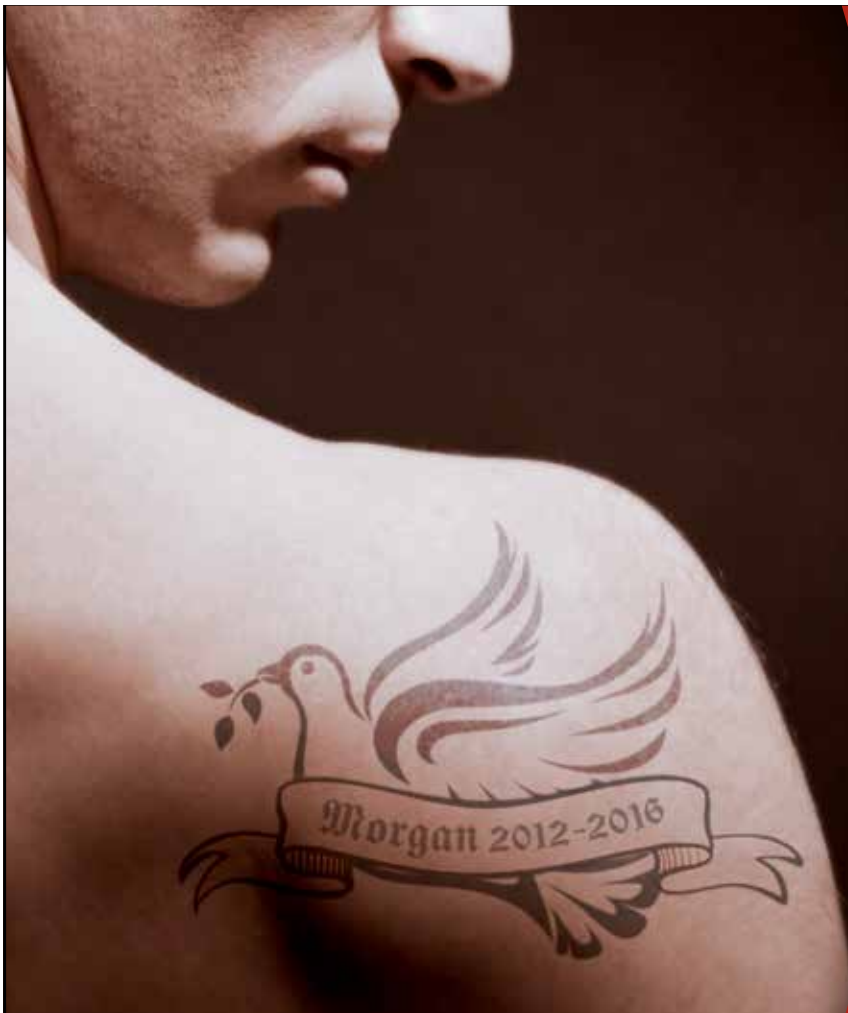
zation must be a paid member of the Electric League, and the activity must to open to any member who receives our newsletter. The newsletter is typically emailed the third week of the month.
