Sporting Clay Shooting Event

Plan to attend the Sporting Clays event set for Wednesday, October 4 at Powder Creek Shooting Park in Lenexa, Kansas. The event will be held rain or shine.

The event begins with registration at 11 a.m., followed by lunch and a chance to participate in a practice round. At 12 p.m., there will be a safety orientation with the clay shoot starting at 12:30 p.m. Awards will be presented at 3 p.m.

The \$70 per person cost includes 100 sporting clays on a 12 station course, lunch and prizes. Ammunition, eye and ear protection are not included in the cost. These items may be purchased on site. The event will feature a five-man team format. However, singles are welcome. Bring your own gun - no pistols or rifles allowed. You can share guns with your teammates but please make arrangements in advance.

The course is 1.3 miles long however you can bring your own golf cart or mule or rent one on site - if needed. Cart shuttles will be provided at two lengthy stretches on the course.
